

# European Trial Championships

## LICENCE INFORMATION 2018

From January 2017 all rider's licenses issued by Continental Unions (CONU) will be harmonised and sold by FIM to National Federations (FMN) online from the FIM Extranet. Some changes to the name of the different licenses have been made also for 2018. Also, there are some changes regarding what licence can be used in specific categories.

Please notice that when an FIM Trial International Meetings Licence is used (International Classes and all assistants), the rider must bring the paper printout. This license is no longer free, but will cost €11 for the FMN to purchase. All the different designed licenses in «credit card» format, issued by the FMN will no longer be accepted unless it is accompanied by the printout from FIM Extranet.

To avoid any misunderstanding, we have made the table below where you can see what licences are valid for different classes (categories) in the European Trial Championship events.

Rider's class or role	Valid licence(s)
<b>FIM Europe Trial European Championship</b>	Annual or one-event Trial Continental Championship licence.
<b>FIM Europe Over-40 Trial Cup</b>	Annual or one-event Trial Continental Championship licence.
<b>FIM Europe Junior Trial Cup *</b>	Annual or-one event Trial Promotional Continental Championships license (or a Trial Continental Championship Licence).
<b>FIM Europe Women's Trial Championship *</b>	Annual or-one event Trial Promotional Continental Championships license (or a Trial Continental Championship Licence).
<b>FIM Europe Youth Trial Championship</b>	Annual or-one event Trial Promotional Continental Championships license (or a Trial Continental Championship Licence).
<b>All International Classes</b>	FIM Trial International Meeting License issued by FIM Extranet (or any other valid Continental Trial licence). For events organised in their own country, the riders may use a National License.
<b>Assistants</b>	Annual or one-event FIM or FIM Europe Trial Assistant license, FIM Trial International Meeting License or any other FIM or FIM Europe trial license. However, a registered assistant may use a valid National Trial license in the assistant's own country.

\* Observe that a continental promotional licence can now be used in this category
